Bloodborne Pathogens 29 CFR 1910.1030
Select employees who may be occupationally exposed to blood or other potentially infectious materials must be trained upon assignment and receive annual refresher training.



Chemical Hygiene Plan 29 CFR 1910.1450
Select employees who work with chemicals in a laboratory setting must receive initial and annual training in the company's written Chemical Hygiene Plan. Refresher training is required when laboratory, chemicals and/or standard operating procedures change.



Control of Hazardous Energy (LOTO) 29 CFR 1910.147
Select employees who are authorized to perform lock-out / tag-out must be initially trained and receive annual training. All other affected employees must receive initial and annual training on the company's lockout / tagout program and prohibitions.



DOT Hazardous Materials 49 CFR 172.704
Select employees who handle hazardous materials (loading, unloading, preparing for shipment, etc.) must receive initial training in hazardous materials and USDOT basic requirements. Retraining is required at least once every three (3) years.



Hazardous Wastes 40 CFR 265.16
Any employee who generates or otherwise handles a hazardous waste must be initially trained in hazardous waste management methods, the company's contingency plan, and preparedness and prevention methods. Annual retraining is required for LQGs.



Emergency Action Plans 29 CFR 1910.38
All employees must receive initial training in the company's emergency plan. Although annual training is not required, refresher training must be provided whenever any element of the written emergency action plan is changed.



Hazard Communication 29 CFR 1910.1200
All employees must receive initial training in the company's written hazard communication program (MSDSs, Labeling, etc.). Although annual training is not required, refresher training should be considered due to the complexity of the subject.



HAZWOPER General Awareness 29 CFR 1910.120
Any employee who may witness a chemical emergency must be initially trained in the ways to recognize hazardous materials and emergency situations and the steps that they should take upon discovery.



HAZWOPER First Responder 29 CFR 1910.120
Select employees who are designated to respond defensively to a plant emergency by diking a spill, shutting down equipment or taking other defensive actions must be initially trained for 8 hours. Annual 8 Hour refresher training is required.



HAZWOPER 8 HR Annual Refresher 29 CFR 1910.120
Select employees at the First Responder level and any other HAZWOPER employee at the technician, specialist, and or incident commander level must receive annual 8 hour refresher training.



Hearing Conservation 29 CFR 1910.95
Select employees who are exposed to 85 dB TWA of noise averaged over an 8 hour shift must receive a baseline audiogram and training. Annual hearing tests and training in ways to protect against hearing loss are required for such employees.



Confined Spaces 29 CFR 1910.146
Employees who are authorized to enter into confined spaces must receive initial and annual training in the steps to take to protect themselves when conducting a confined space entry.



Personal Protective Equipment 29 CFR 1910.132 - .138
Any employee who must wear personal protective equipment (safety glasses, gloves, etc.) must be initially trained in the proper donning, wearing, cleaning, care and limitations of the PPE. Refresher training is required for employees who demonstrate a lack of understanding of the company's PPE requirements.



Respiratory Protection 29 CFR 1910.134
Any employee who must wear a respirator on a non-voluntary basis, including employees who voluntarily wear any respirator other than a dust mask, must receive initial and annual training, and fit testing.
